<p><b>ASH WEDNESDAY:</b> The season of Lent begins with <b>Ash Wednesday, February 25<sup>th</sup></b>. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Every Friday in Lent is also a day of abstinence.</p>

**On days of abstinence,** flesh meat is not to be eaten. This law applies to those who are 14 years and older.

**On days of fast,** one full meal is allowed, along with two lesser meals the same day. This law of fast applies to those between the ages of 18 and 59.
