DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST: The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has designated the weekend of **June 27 and 28** as the Holy Father's Peter's Pence Collection. The purpose of the collection is to provide the Holy Father with the financial means to respond with emergency assistance to those who are suffering as a result of war, oppression, natural disaster and disease. This collection enables the Pope to respond with promptness, love and compassion to our suffering brothers and sisters, so that those who suffer will not feel alone in time of misfortune. Pope Benedict VI once explained that those who are baptized create one family of believers who are never alone. The Peter's Pence collection unites us in solidarity to the Holy Father and with the Holy Father's works of charity. Peter's Pence Collection derives its name from an ancient custom in Ninth Century England.
