Then to immediately come up on the altar to be ready to distribute Holy Communion. In regards to receiving the Precious Blood, you are asked to use common sense. If you feel ill or are just getting over a cold or the flu, please refrain from receiving from the chalice. The same applies to the Sign of Peace. If you are ill or are just getting over the flu or a cold, please refrain from shaking hands at the Sign of Peace. A simple bow or smile to your neighbor in the pew will suffice. Also if someone does not wish to shake hands with you, please do not feel offended. These practices are only temporary until circumstances improve. Thank you for understanding.
